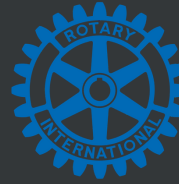


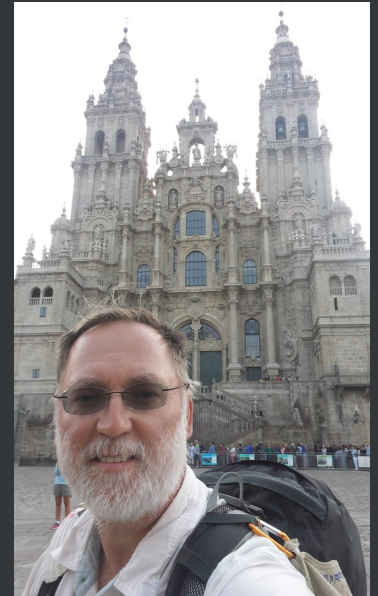

The Camino de Santiago is a 1,200 year old pilgrimage route. In July and August 2018, for 29 days and 556 miles, Roland P. Weimer walked the Camino. He traveled from the foothills of the Pyrenees in Southern France, across the sun-drenched landscapes of Northern Spain, to Santiago de Compostela, then further on to Finisterre, believed to be "the edge of the world."

He will share his experiences, stories and images about the centuries-old route and its modern-day popularity. He will reflect on this journey on foot through history and into the soul, and what makes the people who walk the Camino find hidden truths about their own lives.
