



Juticalpa Roatan Honduras Water Project



The community of Juticalpa is located in the municipality of Santos Guardiola on the island of Roatan, Honduras. Juticalpa has a population of 750 people. Most residents work in tourism, construction, and the fishing industry. The average monthly income per family is \$370 USD.

40% of the community has access to a limited water supply. In the summer, water is available on 1 day every 2 weeks. In the winter, water is available 1 day every week. The existing well does not recharge very quickly so it takes 1 to 2 weeks to fill the community water tank. The remaining 60% of the community has no access to water.

The goal of this Rotary project is to provide potable water to 100% of the community.
